PERFORMANCES Six performances between **Friday 17 and Sunday 26 April 2026**. The production will be

single-cast, with a full cover cast.

THE DIRECTORS. Our Joint Production Directors are **Eleanor Burke and Alex Gotch.**

Eleanor Burke was previously a staff director at Theater Krefeld und Mönchengladbach. Eleanor became the youngest director ever accepted onto the Jette Parker Young Artists Programme (2022-24) at the Royal Opera House, London. Her 2023 production of *The Cunning Little Vixen* for HGO won the 2023 Offie Award for opera production, as did her production for us of *Eugene Onegin* in 2024. Other recent work includes William Gardner/Matthew Green *The Prisoner* (Royal Academy of Music); 555: *Verlaine en Prison* (La Monnaie, Brussels and ROH Crush Room); *La Voix Humaine* (King's Head Theatre); *Bluebeard's Castle* (Green Opera) and *TIDE* (Britten Pears Arts, Aldeburgh Festival).

Alex Gotch is an award-winning Director, Movement Director and Choreographer. He was a semi-finalist in the European Opera-Directing Prize 2025. His credits as Associate Director include La Cenerentola (ETO) and Pelleas et Melisande (Longborough). As Movement Director/Choreographer - Werther (Opera Comique), The Rake's Progress (ETO), Eugene Onegin (HGO), Jane Eyre (Arcola), Figaro (Waterperry), Dido and Aeneas (Theatre Royal Bath), and Don Giovanni Tenorio (RCM). As Assistant Director - La Bella Dormente nel Bosco and L'enfant et les Sortileges (RCM), The Pilgrim's Progress (BYO) and Poppea (ETO).

Our Music Director **Oliver Cope** was the winner of the 2024 International Athens Conducting Competition. He graduated with First Class Honours from the University of Cambridge and the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland (Hugh S Robertson Prize for Conducting), and has studied with prominent conductors including Martyn Brabbins, Sian Edwards, and Johannes Schlaefli. In the UK, he has worked with the Royal Scottish National Orchestra, Scottish Opera, and the National Symphony Orchestra Dublin, Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra, and many others in Europe as well. In Opera, Oliver is a regular member of the Music Staff at Grange Park Opera, and *Lucretia* marks his return to HGO after a successful debut in 2024 with *Eugene Onegin*.

APPLICATIONS

We invite applicants to notify their interest to our Auditions Secretary Kathy Dallas (123kathy.dallas@gmail.com) as soon as convenient, and no later than 18 October. Please include in your application the following:

- Your professional CV
- Contact details including telephone, e-mail and postal address
- The role/s for which you wish to apply (if you have particular role(s) in mind, but this is not critical)
- A sound or video recording in the form of video link or video/sound file
- Photo (small and low-resolution please)
- Any dates and times in our proposed audition schedule when you will not be available

AVAILABILITY

Please also consider the rehearsal period (March and April 2026) before applying to ensure that you will be available during this period. We anticipate a minimal number of non-available days, but please let us know at this stage if there are dates you know you cannot do. In creating a rehearsal schedule, we will attempt to be flexible with NA requests that are made well in advance or for important last-minute auditions. In the weeks of March 30 and April 6 and for final rehearsals at the theatre, singers' substantial availability is crucial.

Audition pieces required are specified below.

AUDITION PANEL

The audition panel will include Eleanor Burke, Oliver Cope, Alex Gotch and Philip Sheffield (HGO). Piano accompaniment will be provided; let us know if you would wish to bring your own accompanist.

AUDITION PIECES

Singers should prepare audition pieces as follows:

Male Chorus: aria of choice, plus extract from Lucretia - "Rome is now ruled by the

Etruscan upstart" (Act 1 Scene I) or "The Ride" (Interlude before scene II)

Female Chorus: aria of choice, plus extract from Lucretia: "It is an axiom amongst kings" (Act I

scene 1) or "The prosperity of the Etruscans was due" (start of Act II)

Lucretia: aria of choice, plus extract from Lucretia: "Give him this orchid" (Act II scene

II)

Tarquinius: aria of choice, plus extract from Lucretia: "Within this Frail Crucible of Light"

(Act II scene I)

Other roles: 2 contrasting arias of which at least one should be in English, ideally by

Benjamin Britten.
